WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE PMD

- ✗ Pallet wrapping films and packaging for industrial use (e.g. plastic raw material bags)
- ✗ Packaging of motor oil and lubricants, of pesticides, of fuels, of glues, of paints and varnishes, silicone tubes
- ✗ Packaging > 8 litres
- ✗ Polystyrene
- ✗ Packaging with child-resistant fastenings
- ✗ Packaging featuring one of these pictograms
- ✗ Packaging made of a combination of materials (e.g. plastic film layer + aluminium film layer) which cannot be separated, like some drink, fruit purée or wet pet food pouches etc.
- ✗ Gas cylinders, batteries and electr(on)ical appliances
- ✗ Other items

WARNING!



Do not put items inside one another or put filled, tied up bags into the PMD bag.

Rules for proper recycling



Empty packaging completely.



Flatten plastic bottles lengthwise, put the cap on.



Place films and containers separately in the bag.



Remove full body sleeves from the bottle and throw them separately into the blue bag.



Sorting is good, zero waste is even better!
